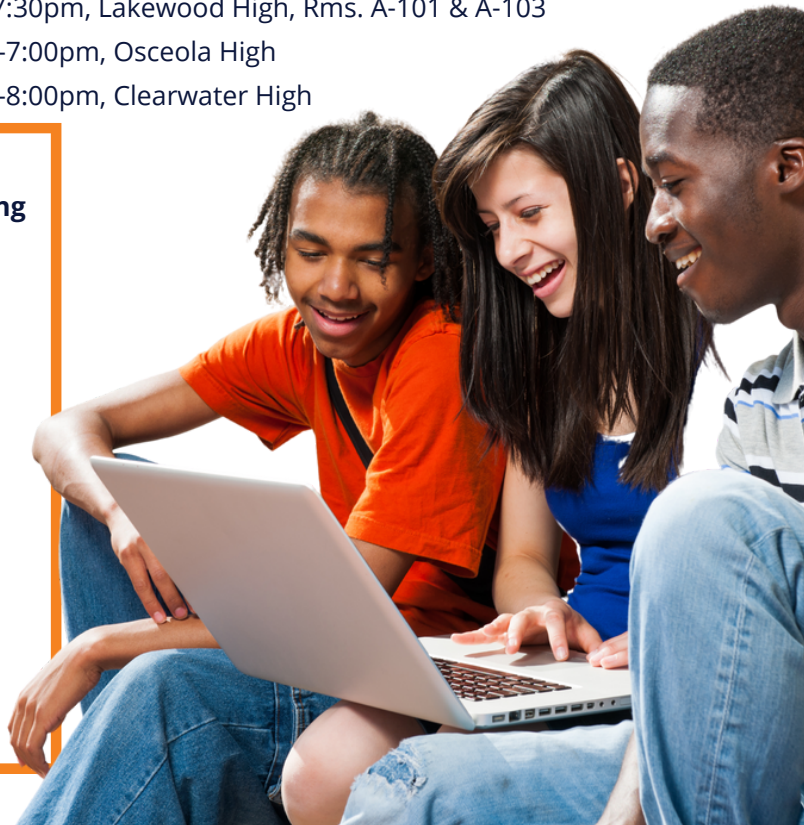
Please arrive no later than 60 minutes prior to the end of the event. All events are located in the school media center unless otherwise specified below.

- 2022 federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned
- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable)
- Net worth of businesses & farms (if applicable)
- Records of 2022 untaxed income (if applicable)
- Child support received from last complete calendar year (if applicable)
- FSA ID (must create one ahead of time at <https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch>)
